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Introduction: polling methodology

This survey was fielded online from May 2 – 7, 2025. The sample size is 1,122 Asian-American and Pacific Islander registered voters.

The sample was recruited through Cint’s Lucid Marketplace from a diverse set of panel providers, employing quota sampling to maximize representativeness. We also generate and apply respondent-level survey weights to account for remaining observable sample imbalance on age, gender, census region, and education.

The margin-of-error for a sample of this size is approximately ± 2.93 (with 0.95 confidence).
